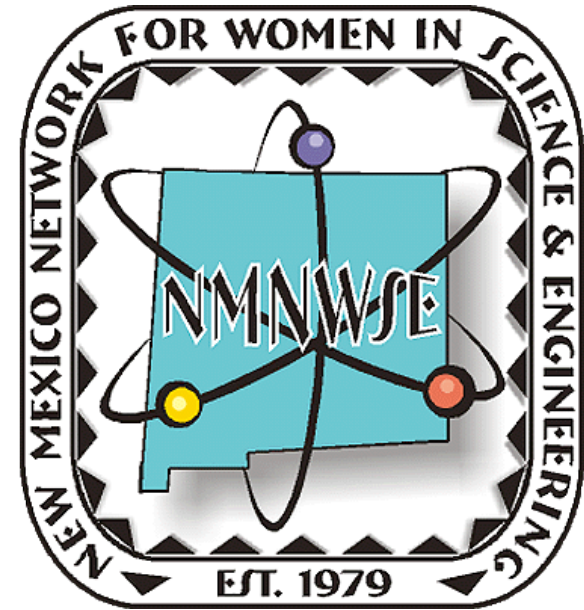

Valles Caldera National Preserve, NM

This year's meeting will be held at the Lodge in the Valles Caldera National Preserve. The preserve was created in 2000 to preserve and protect the historic Baca Ranch of New Mexico's Jemez Mountains, an 89,000-acre land-grant ranch nestled inside a volcanic caldera. The Lodge is situated on the west side of the Valle Grande, the largest valley in the Preserve, and offers spectacular views in a pristine setting. October is prime viewing time for both elk and aspen - staying in the Lodge is an unforgettable experience.

The meeting begins with a Friday evening reception. Saturday morning is the annual business meeting of the Network, followed by technical talks in the early afternoon. The late afternoon features the poster session, an excellent opportunity to network - students, teachers, and non-employed members presenting posters are eligible for a meeting scholarship. Saturday ends with dinner, presentation of the **2010 NMNWSE IMPACT! Award**, and an after-dinner program highlighting the science or history of the Jemez region. Members are invited to stay though Sunday for the first meeting of the new state Board, elected at the business meeting on Saturday.

Registration forms and other details will be posted on the Annual Meeting webpage in mid summer. Early registration closes 10 Sep 2010, with late registrations accepted through the meeting date on a space-available basis.

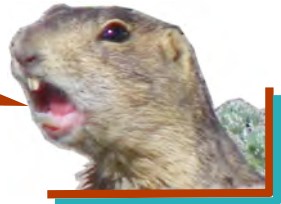

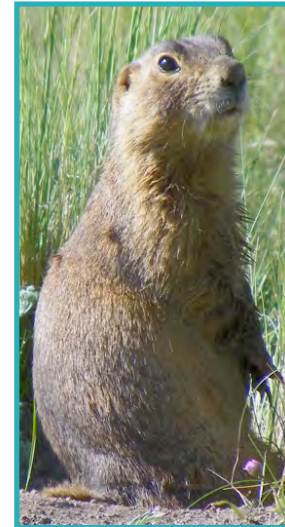

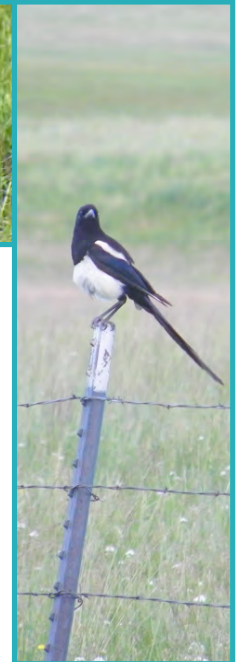
